Molalla Communications Company (MCC) has set aside a sum of funds to be used for educational college tuition scholarships. This scholarship fund is for the benefit of our Membership and their immediate family.

The fund is to be perpetual. The amounts used from it will be decided annually by the Molalla Communications Board of Directors.

In 2012, MCC will be awarding five (5) scholarships in the amounts of \$2,500.00 each to high school seniors who graduate this spring. The scholarship winners will be notified by phone and letter.

2012 Scholarship Application Packet

Molalla Communications maintains a scholarship fund for the benefit of its Members and immediate family. The scholarship is intended to recognize and provide financial assistance to high school graduates pursuing further education in any degree program of study, at any university, 4-year college, community college, technical or trade school.

The scholarship fund is subject to the following rules and regulations:

1. Molalla Communications will present five (5) scholarships in the amounts of \$2,500.00 each. These scholarships are to be used in the academic year beginning September 2012.
2. To be eligible the candidate must be a Molalla Communications Member or immediate family member legally residing in the Member household on the date of the initial award of the scholarship.
3. Selection shall be made by a committee, appointed by the Molalla Communications Board of Directors. Applications shall be modified to remove names so a "blind" selection process may be made.
4. Selection criteria includes: academic achievement, involvement in activities, honors, awards, and career goals. Financial need is not a consideration.
5. Annually, the Molalla Communications Board will determine the number of recipients and amount of awards.
6. Applications must be on the official Molalla Communications application form and received no later than Friday, **March 9, 2012** by Molalla Communications, located at 211 Robbins Street, Molalla. Mail applications to: P.O. Box 360, Molalla, Oregon 97038, attention Scholarship Applications.
7. Candidates must be a current high school senior progressing satisfactorily toward graduation. They must have maintained a 3.0 ("B") average over the last three quarters or two semesters.
8. After initial award, while attending college, university or trade school, a minimum average of 2.0 ("C") must be maintained while carrying a full schedule (12 hours) to remain eligible for future disbursements if offered or available.
9. Recipients must attend a school certified by the Northwest Accreditation Association or a school recognized by the National Association of Trade and Technical Schools.
10. Award payment shall be made directly to the registrar's office in the name of the recipient, following receipt of verified registration at an approved school providing copy of transcript if a returning student.

You will be rated on your ability to respond clearly and accurately to the questions asked. It is important to be clear and concise; yet provide sufficient information to judge your success to date, and your probability for future success to merit scholarship award.

Well-written, thoughtful, error free applications, may influence the committee in addition to the quality of your scholarship and test record.

All prepared application materials should be typewritten or computer generated from a quality printer.

1. Self Introduction: We want to know who you are outside of your accomplishments. Please tell us about yourself in one page or less.
2. Significant Accomplishments: Please describe your top 6-10 significant accomplishments including: activities, talents, volunteer and job/employment. This is your opportunity to tell us about activities that are not evident on your transcript. Be specific and succinct in describing your fervor, your role and what impact you made in your school or community. We value definitive commitments with exceptional results that distinguish you from your peers more than participation in numerous extracurricular activities. Limit your responses to accomplishments achieved within the past three years.
3. Honors, achievements or awards: Please list.
4. Educational and Career Goals: Please explain in one page or less.
