

Setting up a New Email Account in Mozilla Thunderbird

1. Upon first install you will get a Welcome to Thunderbird screen, Select Skip this and use my existing email.

2. If this is a new installation of Thunderbird you will be prompted with a Mail Account Setup
 - **Enter Your Name**, as shown to others
 - Your **molalla.net** Email address
 - Your **password for the email address**

Press Continue

- Thunderbird will try to automatically configure the server information for you and you may see something like this...

- Thunderbird gives you the option of setting up as IMAP or POP, you may use either protocol, but if you use IMAP your storage space is limited to the amount of storage on the server (200 MB). Using POP Thunderbird will automatically leave a copy of the message on the server for a set number of days so multiple computers or devices are able to retrieve them.

- Click on Manual config and change SSL to None on both Incoming and Outgoing
